As part of the **Europe Day celebrations** on May 9, the **EU Goodwill Ambassadors** from Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya and Morocco were invited to Belgium to discover EU institutions, meet EU officials and take part in a number of activities. **Read about the highlights of their journey in this newsletter!**

Meeting with the EU Officials



During their stay, the EU Goodwill Ambassadors met senior officials from the European Commission to discuss the **cooperation priorities** between the European Union and countries of the Southern Neighbourhood.

The 1st meeting took place at the offices of the Directorate-General for European Neighbourhood and Enlargement Negotiations (DG NEAR) in the presence of directors and experts. During their discussions with the EU Goodwill Ambassadors, EU officials present in the meeting underlined **the importance given to youth in the southern region** and the efforts made by the European Union in several areas such as education, training, entrepreneurship, research, the environment or even culture to build a better-greener, more inclusive and digital future.

During the 2nd meeting organised at the offices of the European External Action Service (EEAS), the officials explained **diplomatic ties and political relations with the Southern Neighbourhood**, as well as the importance of strategic communication for the European

SALAM event: an hymn for peace

In these simple but emotional words, Namees Arnous, EU Goodwill Ambassador to Egypt, gave her personal definition of peace at the **SALAM event**, organised on May 4.

The SALAM event was an evening dedicated to **peace**, during which EU Goodwill Ambassadors from the Southern Neighbourhood and Young European Ambassadors from the Eastern Neighbourhood and Western Balkans expressed their solidarity with all nations in the world who are going through conflicts or other forms of strife. In their own language, young participants **sent a unified message of peace to the world.** They also contributed to a live painting by a Belgian artist of the word «Salam», meaning peace in Arabic.
