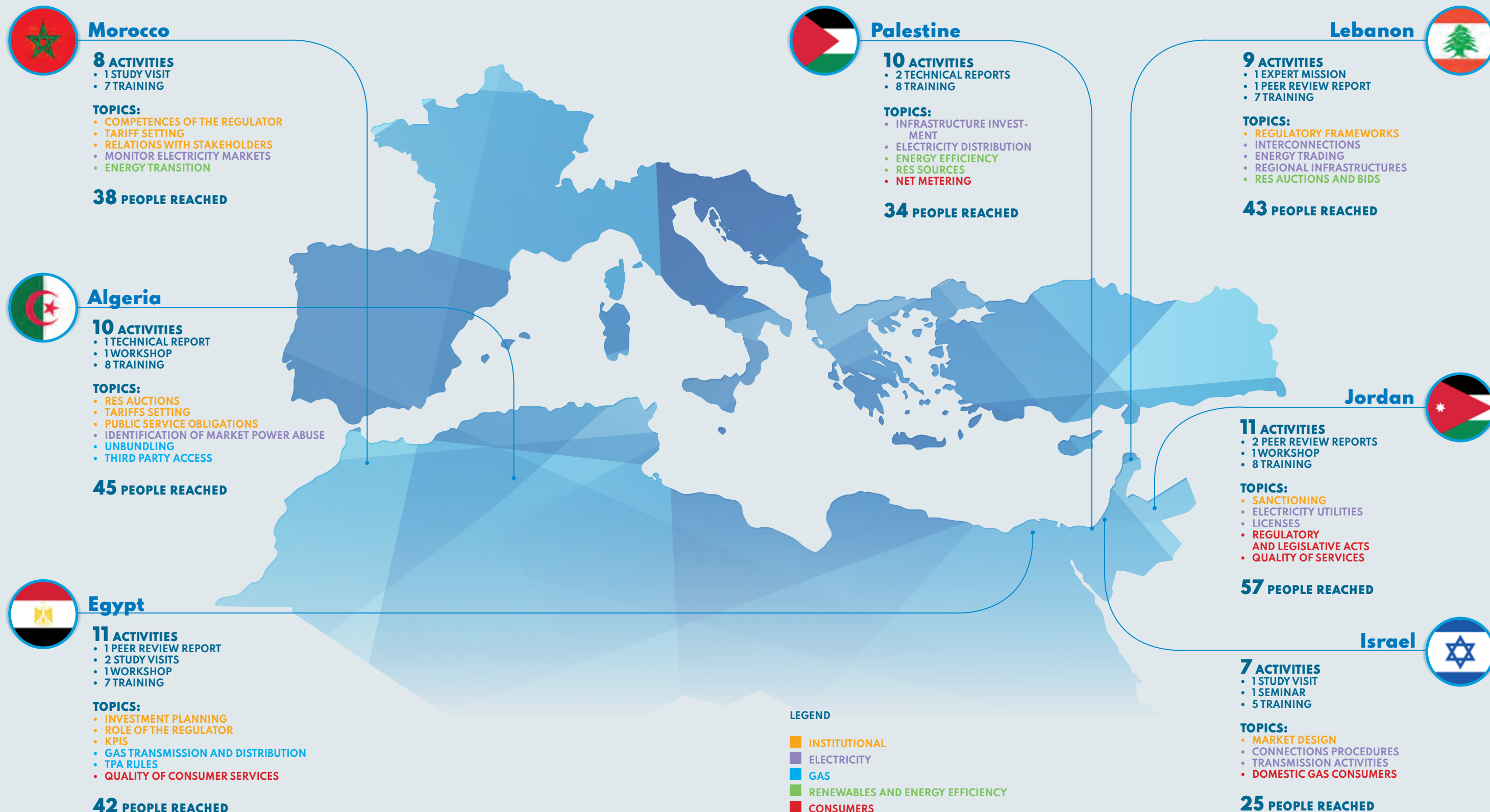

Focuses on the regulation of Renewable Energy Sources generation, with attention to off-grid solutions and independent power producers.



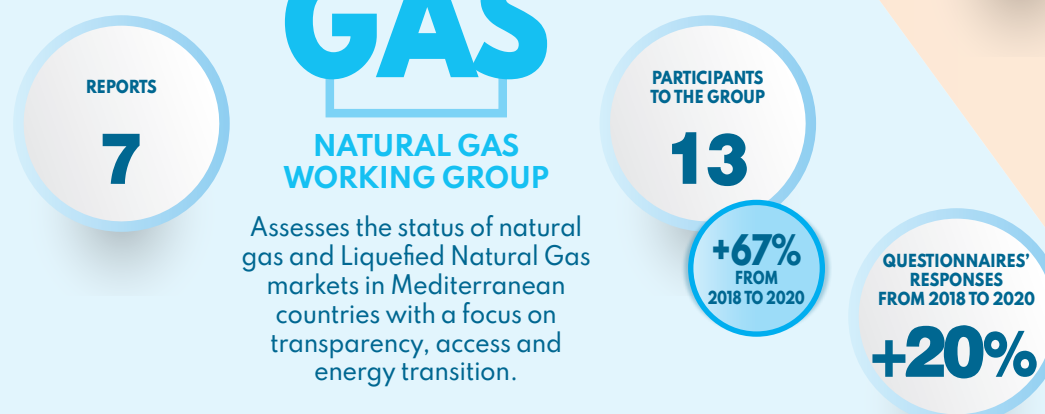
ELE ELECTRICITY WORKING GROUP

Analyses the current regulation of electricity markets to identify and propose basic requirements that will lead to the compatibility of electricity regulation in the MEDREG region.



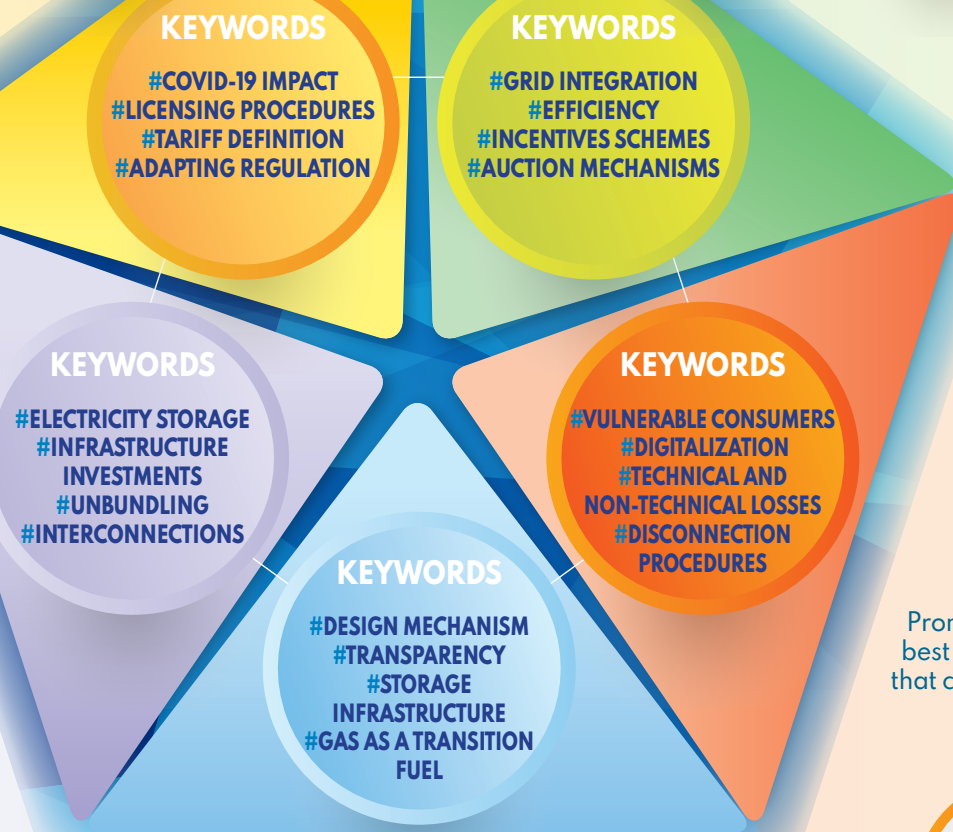
GAS NATURAL GAS WORKING GROUP

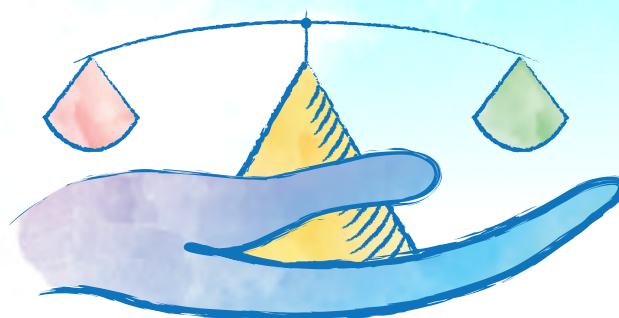
Assesses the status of natural gas and Liquefied Natural Gas markets in Mediterranean countries with a focus on transparency, access and energy transition.
