# **Policy level**

**Diesis Network** following the emerging trends in the MENA region at macro level is organizing three webinars addressed to policy makers of the region by involving European key actors.

Last 14th of July took place the first one, focused on:

"How <u>EASI Programme</u> is funding the development of social enterprises in EU - lessons leamed and elements for transferability."

**Upcoming events starting from September:** 

- Policy to promote employment in the social economy: good examples of initiatives fostering youth's participation in SE from EU and MENA countries will be presented.
- Statistics and their importance for policy development: lack of data is a relevant issue hampering the sound development of proper SE policies. The webinar will bring experiences from within the EU and the Mediterranean region to debate around this issue and compare practices.

#### **Euclid Network**

Euclid Network together with our local partner organizations and key actors of the project countries are currently working on an online platform to serve as an overview of the SE ecosystems in the MENA region. The objective is that this online tool can facilitate breaking silos, raising awareness of the sector and stimulate national and regional collaborations. So far, national events in four out of six project countries took place to discuss how such a platform can be conceived and add value to already existing structures.
