Focussed EU priorities: back to basics

1



Better health and well-being including by regaining lost ground on universal health targets in the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), through:

- Promoting drivers of good health, addressing root causes of ill health
- Particular attention to women, girls and people in vulnerable situations



The pandemic severely disrupted SDG progress. Collectively, countries have only achieved a quarter of what is needed to reach health targets by 2030.

Advancing universal health coverage:

- More equitable primary health care systems
- Better capacity to meet health emergency needs
- Leveraging digitalisation and research
- Addressing workforce imbalances

Combatting health threats, including pandemics:

- New international rules and global surveillance
- Permanent platform for development and vaccine access
- One Health approach
- Control anti-microbial resistance (AMR)

A new approach to global cooperation and partnerships

- **Stronger World Health Organization (WHO)** leading an effective global health system European Commission as full observer at WHO
- **Global governance** without duplication and strong political attention to health
- **Health sovereignty:** Expanded international partnerships based on co-ownership and co-responsibility under Global Gateway
- Increased impact through innovative finance, pooled funding mechanisms and co-investment

New EU governance to ensure leadership

- Mobilising all internal and external policies for global health
- Single and powerful voice of Team Europe
- More coordination with Member States linking actions and funds to health priorities
- Monitoring Global Health Strategy implementation
