
Morrocan EU Jeel Connectors Unite for Flagship Event!

With Morocco boasting the largest network of 46 EU Jeel Connectors, the Flagship Event served as a platform to **highlight their efforts**, offering insights into their meaningful work.

Throughout the year, EU Jeel Connectors took part in Coffee Talks to discuss various EU-supported projects in areas such as education, culture, creative industries and others. They also began implementing their **own initiatives** to showcase their commitment to **relaying EU opportunities** in Morocco.
