## Chasing Stars on the Road - Jordan Edition

"Chasing Stars on the Road", EU Neighbours South's project visit concept continued on 28 October in Jordan. EU Ambassador Pierre-Christophe Chatzisavas and **20 EU Jeel Connectors** had an inspiring day **learning about EU-funded projects** in Zarqa, Muwaqqar and Amman.

The day started with the **Green Links project** at the National Employment and Training Centre in Zarqa where the youth experienced first-hand the maintenance and functioning of solar panels, followed by a visit to the Oasis Centre in Muwaqqar to learn more about the **Resilience and Empowerment of Vulnerable Women project**, a key initiative for Jordan's growth and stability implemented by UN Women. The trip ended at the Nazik Al Hariri Centre for Special Education in Amman, where participants learnt about **EFE's B-LIEVE project**, visited its center and discovered the arts and crafts designed by some of its beneficiaries.

This visit gave participants a deeper insight into the **profound impact of EU-funded initiatives** and allowed them to experience first-hand how these programmes are enriching communities and creating positive change in Jordan.
